

The goal *(1/2)*



- ▶ Most major conferences focus on generic hot topics around Information Security to draw a large audience. Security BSides events go beyond that and explore emerging information security related issue, look forward to emerging (cyber)threats and focus on the matter in hand, while having a low cost event affordable & accessible to everyone (for both participants and sponsors).
- ▶ Security BSides events give everyone a voice for conversation, and don't only scratch the surface of the hot topics. Most importantly, at Security BSides Athens you will not find presentations which are a sales pitch. We focus and accept only actual work, research, opinions, and
- ▶ Remove any constraints like no other conference, by allowing speakers to freely discuss topics, share their personal opinions, and initiate discussions beyond corporate brands and sales pitches.



The goal *(2/2)*



- ▶ Join a global community of events happening all over the world. For example: Las Vegas, San Francisco, London, Manchester, Amsterdam, Vienna, and many more!
- ▶ Provide the platform for rookies and mentors to engage with each other, help develop connections, friendships, and network with different industry professionals from all over the world.

Target audience



- ▶ Each Security BSides event is indented to reach out to the local Information Security community and provide the opportunity to the participants to network, while speakers have the opportunity to be heard and recognised.

- ▶ We target the:
 - Industry professionals looking to offset or augment their current security skill set.
 - Security, risk and compliance professionals from both the public and private sectors (at all industries).
 - University or College academics and students who wish to expand their body of knowledge or want to share their ideas/work.

One day event *(1/2)*



- ▶ **Presentations** and maybe **short workshops** (1-3 hours) on the same day.

- ▶ CTF – Capture the Flag running during the day, in which **everyone** will be able to participate. (TBD)

Why in Greece



- ▶ The Greek InfoSec (cybersecurity) community is growing fast, and it is already well recognised abroad.
- ▶ There is a need for new ideas and innovative solutions in the Greek market which will allow business growth in a secure manner, while young and talented professional are given the opportunity to be recognised and shine.
- ▶ There is a global need for investing in new technologies, adapting cloud services, interconnectivity (Internet of Things) and mobile payments, while CyberSecurity remains a high priority.
- ▶ The rollout of EMV in the US dictates many Greek companies, organisations and banks to review their security strategies and become compliant with PCI DSS in this new era of online payments, especially when it come to cybersecurity.
- ▶ GDPR will require more work to be done and a lot of expertise in the are of Information Security especially when it comes to security and privacy of Personal Identifiable Information (PII).

Exhibition area (1/2)



- ▶ Exhibitors/Sponsors **should bring their own portable display stands/banners/posters and marketing material to the event (see p.19)**. A table, 2 chairs and access to the mains (1 power socket) is included in the cost of sponsorship. Please, bring any extension leads needed.
- ▶ Exhibitors might be given the opportunity to be interviewed by the media. **Sponsor logos will be on roll-up banners placed next to each stage** where the speakers are presenting.
- ▶ **All-day Coffee, Tea, Water, and cookies/cake will be available, and lunch** will be also served to all participants during the event.
- ▶ All participants will receive an **A4 folder or bag, a t-shirt, a lanyard and a badge** (name, company name, and country). *This year we might also have a working circuit board along with the badge (TBD).*

Exhibition area (2/2)



- ▶ All participants will be handed an **A4 size paper folder or bag** with all sponsors details and advertising material (such as A4 brochures), along with a pen and blank sheets to take notes. (**sponsors must provide their brochures** to be included in the folder at least **2 weeks before the event**)
- ▶ **Mobile applications** are already available for download (iOS and Android) which allow users to find information about the event, see the tracks schedule and find directions to the venue. We were the first Security BSides event in the world to do this. (#goPaperless)
- ▶ We welcome your **ideas to improve the experience**. Let us know if you would like to include some kind of free give-away (freebie) for the attendees during registration in the morning (to be handed to the attendees along with the A4 size paper folder. The **sponsors must provide their freebies that want to be included in the folder/bag at registration at least 2 weeks before the event**)

Option A: You can reserve both Platinum slots as one sole Platinum Sponsorship, if you cover the total cost for both sponsoring Platinum slots.

Option B: If you are willing to Sponsor an amount equivalent (or greater) to the cost of 3x Platinum Sponsorship we can include you as an additional level of sponsorship, as **Diamond Sponsor**.

Sponsorship levels (2/5)



- ▶ **Community Support** ..no limit, free of charge on mutual agreement (*terms & conditions apply, see details on Slide 24*)

- ▶ **You ideas!** ..no limit, We are open to hear from you in what way would you prefer to sponsor and support the event. For example, sponsors in the past have donated different types of swag “freebies”, books, prizes for the CTF winners, tickets to other events, or training opportunities. Here are some ideas:
 - **Books** (*Information Security, Computer Forensics, Cyber Security, etc.*)

Sponsorship levels (3/5)



▶ **Platinum**

- Logo at the centre of the screen, bigger than all other logos. The sponsor's advertising material (A4) will be placed first in the give-away folder/bag. Logo on the website (URL) under the sponsors area on top of all other sponsors. Table and chairs at the exhibition area (large table/booth area).



▶ **Gold**

- On-screen logo, underneath the platinum sponsor(s), smaller logo than platinum sponsor(s). The 2 Gold sponsors' advertising material can be an A4 or A5 size leaflet (brochure) in the give away-folder, after the platinum sponsor(s). Logo on the website (URL) under the sponsors area. Table and chairs at the exhibition area (normal size table).



▶ **Silver**

- On-screen logo, underneath gold sponsors, smaller logo than gold sponsors. The 3 Silver sponsors' advertising material can be an A4 or A5 size leaflet (brochure) in the give-away folder. Logo on the website (URL) under the sponsors area. Table and chairs at the exhibition area (table for 2 chairs).



▶ **Bronze**

- On-screen logo, underneath silver sponsors, smaller logo than silver sponsors. No promotional material in the give away folder (can have business cards or arrange a promotional item e.g. pens, etc.). Logo on the website (URL) under the sponsors area. All bronze sponsors marketing material will be placed in 1 long table.

Sponsorship levels (4/5)



▶ After-Party

- On-screen logo, by itself, after all other sponsorship levels have been presented. Can provide an A4 leaflet (brochure) in the give-away folder placed behind the other sponsors' material, or instead of a brochure can arrange a promotional item to be given along with the give-away folder e.g. stress ball, pens, etc. Logo on the website (URL) by itself, under the dedicated After-Party area. Table and chairs at the exhibition area. Only the After-Party sponsor is allowed to have their banner(s) in the After-Party area (free to put up any size banners or marketing material you like).

▶ Green Planet Sponsor *(new)*

- On-screen logo, by itself, after all other sponsorship levels have been presented. Can provide an A4 leaflet (brochure) in the give-away folder placed behind the other sponsors' material, or instead of a brochure can arrange a promotional item to be given to all participants along with the give-away folder that is environmental friendly. Such as, **reusable water bottles, reusable coffee cups, reusable bags, power banks**, etc. Logo on the website (URL) by itself, under the dedicated Green Planet section. Table and chairs at the exhibition area.

▶ Awesomeness Sponsor *(new)*

- Each year we have all-day soft drinks/coffee/tea, along with a basic lunch offered to all participants. - Please see an illustration on how roll-up **banners** should look like:
- Sponsors are expected to bring their own custom banners.
- The space allocated for each sponsor in the exhibition area **is limited**, thus “roll-up banners” (e.g. 2x0.80) are ideal for the event. “Curved pop-up stands” are also acceptable.
- **Platinum** and **After-Party** Sponsors are allowed to bring roll-up banners, curved pop-up stands, or flat screens. Please inform Security BSides Athens organisers if unsure about the sizes and limitation in the exhibition area.

- ▶ Security BSides Reception
 - The day before: will be held for **sponsors, speakers, well known security professionals** and **guest/keynote speaker(s), review committee**. (the information about this get-together will not be publicly available)
- ▶ Security BSides Registration and Event
 - On the day of the event as advertised: **Registration** will open at 9:45 am, kicking off at 10:15 am. **Tickets** will be made available online through **Eventbrite** (Tickets for InfoSec professionals & students*). **Closing remarks** at 17:15 pm and the event will finish at 17:30 pm. (Schedule to be updated if needed)
- ▶ Security BSides post-event (after party)
 - Open to all **registered** participants by presenting their **event badge**. They will be entitled to drinks which will be provided by the **After Party** sponsor for approximately 250-300 people. (After Party location will be decided and announced on our website)

Housekeeping rules (1/3)



- ▶ Due to the nature of the event certain restrictions are placed in order to ensure the recognition of **Security BSides Athens** as a prestigious and trustworthy conference by the InfoSec community.
 - Attendees names, phone numbers, email addresses (personal or company), and in general any details provided for event registration purposes, **will not be shared with the Sponsors** (*before or after the event*). Security BSides Athens has a strict policy on respecting the privacy of attendees.
 - If a participant want his/her information deleted after the event, they simply need to unsubscribe from the mailing list (*the unsubscribe link is provided in the communication emails*).
 - Companies or sponsors **should not be represented by sales persons only!** Those organizations **must** be represented by security architects, system engineers or people of relevant status (e.g. executives) and techies in order to interact with the participants throughout the event (*learning curves, discussions on various matters of security, security tools, security concerns, technical considerations, hands-on security assessments*).
 - Sponsors are allowed to hand out marketing/promotional material during the event (*pass them around or having them at their table*) and they **may ask the attendees for their contact details themselves**.



Housekeeping rules (2/3)



► Call for Presentations (CFP)

- **The submissions** for talks and presentations will be reviewed by the **committee** as listed on the Security BSides Athens webpage. Their individuals' names will also be available on the Security BSides wiki website: www.securitybsides.com
- **Sponsors:** submitted talks will go through review as well for relevance. The content needs **to promote the research and discuss problems/solutions/tactics** in security, cybersecurity and cyberdefense. The talks **must not be a direct advertisement** of the sponsoring company (direct sales pitch). Talks need to be **InfoSec related**, and submitted by the CFP deadline.
- Submitted talks and workshops **must not** be a sales pitch and should not cover any sort of “direct marketing” during the presentation.
- Talks/Presentations must be kept up to 30 minutes including Q&A. (25minutes + 5 minutes Q&A)
We had amazing feedback from participants that they loved the 30' presentations and also pushes presenters to stick to the point.
- Lightning talks (if any) will be strictly 15 minutes including Q&A.
- The whole of the **event will be held in English**, including all the talks and presentations.
- There is a possibility of a separate “rookie track” with a couple slots for presentation to be held in Greek. We do this in order give younger talents the opportunity to present their work more comfortably to the local InfoSec community.



Housekeeping rules (3/3)



► Sponsors and Exhibition Area

- Banners/Posters/Advertising material must not extend beyond 1 metre from the sponsor's stand (table), which will be provided. The allocation of a sponsor's table size and space allocation within the exhibition area **will be predetermined** (and it is final) based on their sponsorship level.
